
Some Numbers To Consider

Mission, Ministry, and Money

Thriving parishes have a clear and strong sense of their mission. They also have a good sense of the connection between their mission, their ministries, and their money. The Narrative Budget is intended to help us see all of our expenses in light of our mission. For example, a regular line item on the operating budget like "Electric Bill", while seemingly mundane, is actually the means by which we use our building for worship and learning. When your pledge goes towards the electric bill, it is still going towards the mission of our church!



Worship – Liturgy, Director of Music salary, clergy and staff salaries, vestments, printing, music licensing, acolytes, vergers, LEM's, utilities, organ & piano maintenance, sound system, children's chapel.

Love – Fellowship Groups, Coffee hour, Third Sunday Lunch, Pastoral Care, clergy salaries, administration.

Learn – Adult Education, Youth Ministry, Sunday School, VBS, Family Ministries, Confirmation, Nursery, staff salaries, administration.

Serve - Outreach, Social Issues, staff salaries, administration
